RICHLAND COUNTY COMMUNITY PARTNERS OFFER FREE COVID-19 DRIVE-THRU TESTING

Richland Center, WI: A collaborative effort has been established between Richland County Emergency Management, Richland County Health & Human Services, and the Richland Hospital Clinic to offer ongoing FREE COVID-19 community testing events.

A FREE COVID-19 drive-thru community testing site will be offered **Monday, September 28th** and every Monday through the end of the year **from 9am-1pm at the Richland County Fairgrounds**. Individuals will have to be a Richland County resident and meet specific testing criteria. Tests will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis for the following:

- ✓ Individuals in need of a test for employment purposes.
- ✓ Families in need of a test for school.
- ✓ People who have had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with someone with **confirmed** COVID-19, regardless of symptoms.
- ✓ People who have been asked or referred to get testing by Richland County Public Health, regardless of symptoms.
- ✓ People who have been instructed by a health care provider to get a COVID-19 test for the purpose of infection control, regardless of symptoms.
- ✓ People who have recently developed **any one or more** of the following symptoms:
 - Fever, defined as a measured temperature greater than 100.4°F
 - Subjective fever, for example if a person feels unusually warm to the touch, or reports sensations similar to previous experiences of fever

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Headache
- Chills or rigors (repetitive shaking chills)
- Myalgia (muscle aches)
- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Nasal congestion or runny nose

The collaborative partners will continue to evaluate the needs of the community and may offer additional community testing events in the future.
