RICHLAND COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH REPORTS TWO ADDITIONAL COVID-19 RELATED DEATHS

Richland Center, WI: Richland County Health Officer, Rose Kohout announced this

afternoon that Richland County has experienced two additional COVID-related deaths.

Kohout confirms the eleventh and twelfth COVID-related deaths of a Richland County

resident. Richland County offers their heartfelt sympathies to the family, and out of

respect for the individual's confidentiality and the privacy of the resident's family, no

additional information will be provided. As of 3:00pm Wednesday, November 18th there

were 741 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Richland County, 7,504 have tested negative,

there are 297 active cases, and 432 individuals who had tested positive have been

released from quarantine. Of those 741 individuals who tested positive, 729 individuals

have been recovering at home, 35 have been hospitalized at some point, and there are

now 12 COVID-19 related deaths.

Richland County Public Health continues to work with state and local partners, as well as

health care providers, to reduce the spread of COVID-19 and to help protect the health

and safety of Richland County residents. The public should follow steps to avoid getting

sick including:

-More-

- Stay 6 feet from others;
- Avoid social gatherings with people of all ages;
- Frequent and thorough hand washing with soap and water;
- Use of hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available;
- Wear a mask;
- Covering coughs and sneezes (into the sleeve or elbow);
- Regularly clean high-touch surfaces;
- Do not shake hands;
- Avoid touching your face; and
- Stay home.
