RICHLAND COUNTY EXPECTING SIGNIFICANT DELAYS WITH TEST RESULTS

Gudgeon announced this afternoon that, due to complications outside of our control, we

are expecting significant delays in the return of test results from the COVID-19 testing

event held at the Richland County Fairgrounds on Monday, November 16th. Gudgeon

reports "we are doing everything we can to ensure these issues will not happen again, so

you will be able to receive notification within a reasonable amount of time. While in the

past test results may have been received already today, we are expecting that results will

not be available until this weekend. We sincerely apologize for the delay, appreciate

your patience, and understand the inconvenience this may cause."

results due to a delivery/processing issue.
