You will then receive up-to-date alerts regarding local COVID testing sites and vaccination clinics, severe weather, public safety, criminal activities, missing persons, traffic issues, and local events.

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services reports that as of today 48.7% of Richland County residents have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and 46.2% are fully vaccinated. Richland County citizens age 65 and older who have received at least one dose totals 81.5%.
