FREE COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINIC OFFERED IN RICHLAND COUNTY

WALK-INS ARE WELCOME

Richland Center, WI: Richland County Health & Human Services and Richland County Emergency Management will be offering a FREE COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic in the Auditorium Lobby of the RICHLAND CENTER HIGH SCHOOL, 1996 US Highway 14, Richland Center:

Wednesday, July 14th from 8:30am-4:30pm

1st Pfizer Dose for ALL Wisconsinites 12+ & For 2nd Dose Pfizer Individuals

Individuals who received their 1st Pfizer vaccine dose on June 23rd are <u>REMINDED THAT THEY ARE</u>

<u>PRE-SCHEDULED TO GET THEIR 2ND VACCINE DOSE ON WEDNESDAY, July 14th.</u>

To schedule, currently eligible individuals should go to https://richlandhospitalclinics.rsvpify.com/ or https://richsjuly14th.rsvpify.com/ select a time at the "Richland Center High School" location. Once scheduled, individuals should arrive to their appointment only 5 minutes early - MASKS & SOCIAL DISTANCING ARE REQUIRED. We will be administering the Pfizer vaccine which requires two doses, and the second dose will need to be administered 21 days after the administering of the first dose. Your second dose appointment will be scheduled immediately after receiving your first dose. While this vaccination is not required, it is highly recommended, and will be provided at no out-of-pocket cost to you.

Populations who are now "currently eligible" to receive the vaccine includes <u>ALL WISCONSINITES 12+</u>. The following vaccine clinic partners are currently offering vaccines in Richland County:

- The Richland Hospital and Clinics offers COVID-19 vaccinations during normal business hours. Currently eligible populations will be offered a vaccine during hospital or clinic appointments. Walk-in requests are accepted. To schedule an appointment, please call 608-647-1820.
- Richland County Health & Human Services and Richland County Emergency
 Management offers FREE COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics at the Richland Center
 High School weekly on Wednesdays from 8:30am-4:30pm and walk-ins will
 be accepted. Currently eligible populations should go to
 https://richlandhospitalclinics.rsvpify.com/ to schedule an appointment.
- Center Pharmacy offers COVID-19 vaccinations by appointment only on
 Thursdays from 3:00pm-5:30pm. Currently eligible populations should go to
 https://richlandhospitalclinics.rsvpify.com/ to schedule an appointment.

Individuals needing assistance with making an appointment should call the Richland Hospital COVID-19 Hotline at 608-647-1820 or Richland County Health & Human Services at 608-647-8821. Richland County residents are encouraged to sign-up for NIXLE alerts by texting 53581 to 888777 or go to www.nixle.com to sign-up to receive informational emails. You will then receive up-to-date alerts regarding local COVID testing sites and vaccination clinics, severe weather, public safety, criminal activities, missing persons, traffic issues, and local events.

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services reports that as of today 49.1% of Richland County residents have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and 46.7% are fully vaccinated. Richland County citizens age 65 and older who have received at least one dose totals 81.6%.
