RICHLAND COUNTY COMMUNITY PARTNERS REVIEW WEEKLY COVID-19 VACCINATION & TESTING EFFORTS

Richland Center, WI: A virtual Emergency Operations Center (EOC) meeting was held today to share information between Richland County officials and community partners in a joint response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Health & Human Services Director, Tracy Thorsen announced that as of 2:00pm Wednesday, October 13th the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) confirmed that in the state of Wisconsin there were 759,278 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 8,217 COVID-19 related deaths. In Richland County, Thorsen announced that there were 1,931 confirmed cases of COVID-19, 9,325 have tested negative, and there were 20 COVID-19 related deaths. Richland County Public Health now has 188 active cases and 128 individuals have been hospitalized at some point.

Emergency Management Director, Darin Gudgeon announced the number of individuals tested at COVID-19 community testing events held weekly at the Richland County Fairgrounds. On October 7th 63 individuals were tested and another 47 individuals were tested on October 11th. The results of those 110 tests will be included in the appropriate county's totals once they are received and verified.

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services reports that as of today 54.7% of Richland County residents have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and 52.5% are fully vaccinated. Richland County citizens age 65 and older who have received at least one dose totals 81.0%.
