RICHLAND COUNTY COMMUNITY PARTNERS REVIEW WEEKLY COVID-19 VACCINATION & TESTING EFFORTS

Richland Center, WI: A virtual Emergency Operations Center (EOC) meeting was held today to share information between Richland County officials and community partners in a joint response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Due to the Thanksgiving holiday, there will be no EOC meeting on Thursday, November 25th. Public Health Manager/Local Health Officer, Rose Kohout announced that as of 2:00pm Wednesday, November 17th the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) confirmed that in the state of Wisconsin there were 837,418 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 8,812 COVID-19 related deaths. In Richland County, Kohout announced that there were 2,243 confirmed cases of COVID-19, 9,831 have tested negative, and there were 26 COVID-19 related deaths. Richland County Public Health now has 128 active cases and 167 individuals have been hospitalized at some point.

Emergency Management Director, Darin Gudgeon announced the number of individuals tested at COVID-19 community testing events held weekly at the Richland County Fairgrounds. Due to the Veterans Day holiday, there was no testing on November 11th and 18 individuals were tested on November 15th. The results of those 18 tests will be

included in the appropriate county's totals once they are received and verified. **Due to** the Thanksgiving holiday, there will be no testing on Thursday, November 25th.

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services reports that as of today 55.5% of Richland County residents have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and 53.2% are fully vaccinated. Richland County citizens age 65 and older who have received at least one dose totals 81.6%.
